

## **2009 ANNUAL REPORT RECREATION COMMITTEE**

The following are the major accomplishments and highlights of the Recreation Committee during 2009.

1. Water heater replaced and Federal Government mandated drains installed at the Desoto pool.
2. Fabric desk chairs in the Coronado Center Library re-upholstered.
3. Storage building constructed at the Ponce de Leon Center to house Woodland's outdoor scissor lift and maintenance equipment for the Veteran's Memorial.
4. Cortez Pavilion restrooms painted and new flooring installed.
5. Cortez Beach restrooms painted and re-tiled. New roof shingles installed.
6. Chelsea system installed at Family Recreation.
7. New outdoor carpeting laid on Court 5 and carpeting stretched on other courts as well as new sideboards installed and parking gravel laid at the Booce Courts.
8. Steps constructed at the Lawn Bowling area.
9. New speakers installed at the Coronado Community Center.
10. Changes made to the original Desoto Park plan;
  1. Omit the RV Park.
  2. Omit Desoto Blvd. Entrance.
  3. Revise South approach to Desoto Beach; use Distal Southwest Section closer to spillway.
  4. Change "Day Camp" designation to "Picnic and Beach Area".
  5. Block current entry from Seville Circle to Beach area.
11. Natatorium roof replaced, new lighting and flooring installed. Painting and geo thermal completed . Whirlpool area separated from pool area and one

sauna converted to a steam room.

12. Pickleball courts painted and touched-up prior to the Pickleball Senior Olympics.
13. Back gate installed at Pickleball Courts to allow players to enter and exit courts without disturbing front courts.
14. Two treadmills added to the Fitness Center as well as a new Summit Trainer and bench added to the Weight Room.
15. Re-construction of sub-surface waterlines, sloping and re-surfacing of Tennis Courts 7 through 10 completed.
16. Drainage at the side of the Coronado Community Center issue addressed and corrected.
17. Power Point Computer permanently installed at the Ponce de Leon Center.
18. Handrail installed in the control room at the Woodlands.
19. Drainage ditch installed around back of Tennis Courts 1 through 6 alleviating water build-up.
20. New sign designating Coronado Library installed next to Butterfly Garden.
21. Retaining wall constructed at Cortez beach to prevent gravel from washing into lake.
