

## SANITATION RULES & REGULATIONS

- I. **YARD WASTE - call in required (501-922-5524) – must be at street**
  - A. Yard Waste Tag Required - 50¢ per bag, can, or bundle (sold at POA)
  - B. Bagged Leaves - limited to 50 bags at a time – 45 gallon capacity
  - C. Trimmings
    - 1. Shrubbery
    - 2. Grass
    - 3. Limbs - bundled, 4' or less, weights less than 40 lbs.
    - 4. Lumber – untreated and unpainted, 4' lengths or shorter
  
- II. **RESIDENTIAL – HOUSEHOLD TRASH (trash can must be no larger than 45 gallons)**
  - A. Please use a sealed plastic bag to prevent littering.
  - B. Food Products
  - C. Plastic Products
  - D. Paper Products
  - E. Metal Containers
  - F. Paint Cans – Dried with Lids Off
  - G. Light Bulbs
  
- III. **COMMERCIAL**
  - A. Contact Public Works for special provisions
  
- IV. **RECYCLABLE MATERIAL – DROP OFF ONLY**
  - A. Newsprint
  - B. Corrugated Cardboard
  - C. Aluminum Cans
  - D. Plastics – PET 1 & 2
  - E. Brown Paper Bags
  
- V. **SPECIAL PICK-UP - call in required (501-922-5524) – must be at street**
  - A. \$25.00 Fee
  - B. Household Generated Refuse – Must be at Curbside
    - 1. Furniture
    - 2. White goods
    - 3. Metal pieces (grills, play equipment, mowers, TV antennas)
    - 4. Tires (special provisions required)
    - 5. Plastic containers (garbage cans)
  
- VI. **ITEMS NOT ACCEPTABLE FOR PICK-UP**
  - A. Chemicals
  - B. Motor oil (can be taken to Hwy 7 site)
  - C. Anti-freeze
  - D. Concrete
  - E. Dirt and rocks
  - F. Construction material
    - 1. Carpet
    - 2. Lumber
    - 3. Wet paint
    - 4. Other
  - G. Batteries – Vehicle/Boat (can be taken to Hwy 7 site)
  - H. Logs
