TIMELINE – MAGELLAN GREENS CONVERSION

There have been questions asked concerning the timeline for the greens conversion from Bent to Bermuda at the Magellan Golf Course. Below is the golf departments estimated timeline showing the flow of the conversion process.

Tues. - May 29 th	Spray greens for the first time to kill the bent grass.
Thur. - May 31 st	Spray green for the second time.
Mon. - June 4 th	Verticut Greens and start collar stripping.
Tues. - June 5 th	Verticut Greens and continue collar stripping.
Wed. – June 6 th	Aerification and continue collar stripping.
Thur. - June 7 th	Aerification and continue collar stripping.
6/7 thru 6/17	Continue collar stripping.
6/14 – 6/15	Feed Greens.
Mon. – June 18 th	Sprigging.
Tues. – June 19 th	Continue sprigging if needed.
6/18 - 7/5	Drainage work on holes 4 – 8.

Mon. – July 5 th	Roll greens for the first time.
Mon. – July 9 th	Mow greens for the first time – Begin sod work on collars
7/9 – 7/20	Sod work on collars and continue drainage work on course
6/20 – 8/27	Grow-in period for new Bermuda greens & collars.
Mon. – 8/30	Tentative course opening.

Regular course maintenance will continue during entire process...

TREES FOR MEMORIALS

In past times, benches with inscribed plaques have been purchased by individuals to be placed on the golf courses in memory of loved ones. Due to various circumstances, including up-keep, repairs, ground maintenance, and the number already placed, has made it time to change the type of memorial.

Effective immediately, trees may be purchased as memorials. The golf courses are currently in need of replacement trees, to be placed in strategic locations. Following are some of the guidelines being worked out:

Type of tree: - Up to 20 gallon trees may be purchased, all of the hardwood/deciduous variety. The golf dept. is currently working with consultants as to which type of trees will best suit our needs. They are looking for trees that are not messy, easily maintained, and ones that will fit in and improve the overall beauty of our golf courses.

Cost: At this time, the estimated cost is \$300.00, depending on the type and size of tree purchased for the memorial.

Memorial Marker: An inscribed plaque will hang from each tree, and as the tree grows, the plaques will be maintained and kept in a good site location. The golf dept. will be responsible for replacement of the plaque, should it deteriorate over time.
